MTC Scholarship—Applications Due Soon

It is that time of year when the Round Mountain Senior Class of 2022 will be deciding which paths to take after high school. There are different ways to thrive after high school. Some may choose a traditional four-year college, the military, or a technical school. For students looking for skills that can jump-start their careers, the MTC program through Great Basin College might be a perfect fit. In the fast-paced, 48-week program, students have access to state-of-the-art technologies and will learn skills from qualified faculty. Students are offered the flexibility to attend the courses in the morning, afternoon or evening depending on their schedule.

This year marks the twenty-eighth year since the MTC Scholarship program was established in 1994 by a group of northern Nevada mines and Great Basin College. The goal of the cooperative still holds true for the education and industry partnership today, and that is to grow our own workforce.

Round Mountain Gold offers five scholarships annually to our local Round Mountain, Tonopah, Duckwater Shoshone and Yomba Shoshone students. Students have the options of learning skills in the following fields: Diesel Technology, Electrical Systems, Industrial Millwright, Instrumentation Technology or Welding. Scholarship recipients will have their full tuition covered with the exception of books and housing. Upon graduation from the MTC program students have the opportunity to come back to full time employment at Round Mountain Gold.

Recently RMGC's Corporate Social Responsibility Specialist spoke to the Round Mountain High School's J4NG students about all the great benefits the MTC program at GBC can offer them. (See cover photo.) The process to apply is simple:



Step 1: Apply for the Great Basin College CTE/MTC Scholarship at: www.gbcnv.edu/mtc

Step 2: Complete the GBC General Application for Admission. This must be completed to receive your GBC Student ID number.

Applications for the MTC scholarship are currently being accepted until March 15. Application must include: three references, resume, letter of interest, transcripts, and ACT/SAT or Accuplacer test scores. - 8. Cats are returned to you late Thursday night. We ask that you provide them with food and water and a warm, dry place to recover.




