Duckwater Youth Program: Exploring Possibilities



The Duckwater Summer Program was founded by Kinross Nevada as an outreach to the youth of Duckwater to provide services and skills trainings to this remote area of central Nevada. Each summer, the youth of Duckwater are given opportunities for personal growth provided by Kinross Nevada and its people from Round Mountain and Bald Mountain.

One of this summer's activities included a visit to the Duckwater community on July 13 by Round Mountain and Bald Mountain folks. Round Mountain's Caleb Trease, Rachel Ray, Leeann Johnson, Haley Hastie, Nicole Silberschlag, Chase Diller, as well as Matt Miller and the CSR intern Autumn Rea from Bald Mountain spent the morning working on life skills with the summer program kids. Chase taught them basic finance and budgeting while Haley talked about interview prep and what to include in a resume. This was followed by some mock inter-



views and lunch.

Then on August 3, the Duckwater youth came to Round Mountain for a tour. After some introductions, Dave Corriveau did a presentation on reclamation. Next they toured the mill with Brant Paulick and Stefanie Jones. The Truck Shop is always a favorite part of any tour as it gives the kids an idea of what it takes to maintain large equipment. And for the final stop, the Duckwater kids were taken to the South Overlook where they got to see the pit with Leeann Johnson.


