St. Jude's Ranch Gets a Clean Up From Kinross

There is a special place in Las Vegas where abused and neglected children can create new lives with new hope. That place is called St. Jude's Ranch for Children. For 55 years, this therapeutic residential treatment facility has provided a safe, nurturing home to thousands of neglected and abused children in Nevada. Such a place deserves some sweat equity and no better crew to provide that than Kinross Nevada.

Thirteen Kinross folks spent the day on September 20 pulling weeds, pressure washing buildings, performing general maintenance tasks, as well as helping get ready St. Jude's new clinic. All the volunteers were happy to be a small part of providing hope and healing for the young residents at this facility.

Mining is a significant industry in the state of Nevada, contrib-

uting to its economic growth and providing employment opportunities. However, there may be areas within the state that are unsure about the benefits that mining brings. To spread awareness and address concerns, strategic community outreach can be employed. Doing outreach outside Round Mountain helps Kinross continuously monitor community feedback and concerns while proactively addressing any misconceptions promptly and transparently.

Giving back in our own community as well as other communities around the state—such as St. Jude's—not only spreads awareness of the benefits of mining, but also allows Kinross and its employees to help others.

4-H Grows Here!


In 4-H we believe in the power of young people!




