RMHS Juniors and Seniors Tour RMGC Mill and Processing



Earlier this spring, high school students from RMHS toured the mill and processing departments at RMGC. For many of these students, this tour completed the scope and sequence of how gold gets from the ground to being poured into a bar. Last year the students' tour included the mine operations and the maintenance department. With this year's processing tour, the kids could get an idea of the full process.

One sophomore, Ava Faga, said, "Something that surprised me was all the processes the ore needs to go through after scooping the dirt out of the pit." The processes that Ava is referring to involve lots of steps with lots of operators and technicians.

There are many careers in milling and processing to consider, the students were shown. Before the tour, Lauren Shyluk, Tyfini Brown, Stephanie Jones, Patrick Reid, and Rachel Ray met the students at the J4NG room at the school to discuss the career possibilities on the processing side of mining. Another student, Kamryn Warczak, noted the various careers in processing. "I was very surprised about how many career progression opportunities there are in mining," she said. "Not only are the jobs physically demanding, but they are also mentally challenging as well," she added. The processing side of mining involves lots of technology and moving parts. Kamryn also found all those challenges interesting and she liked all the aspects of teamwork she saw.

Congratulations to 2023 Recipients of the MTC Scholarship

For nearly 30 years, the MTC Scholarship program has offered local youth an opportunity to learn a skilled trade through Great Basin College in Elko. This program was developed by northern Nevada mines and GBC to grow its own workforce.

Applications are accepted in late winter each year for the MTC Scholarship. Kinross Round Mountain offers four scholarships to local students from surrounding areas including Round Mountain, Tonopah, Duckwater Shoshone, and Yomba Shoshone. Students have the options of learning skills in the following fields: Diesel Technology, Electrical Systems, Industrial Millwright, Instrumentation Technology, or Welding. Scholarship recipients will have their full tuition covered with the exception of books and housing. Upon graduation from the MTC program, students have the opportunity to come back to full time employment at Round Mountain Gold.

This year, all four MTC Scholarships are 2023 RMHS graduates. First up is Andy Alvarez. Andy is a motivated, friendly and funny young man. He is excited to come back and work for RMGC after completing his electrical systems certification at GBC. Second on the list is Luis Damian. Luis is smart and kind and likes to play the guitar in his free time. He will be pursuing an electrical degree through GBC and the MTC Scholarship.

Lila Stritenberger is a very bubbly young lady who is always smiling. She will be entering the Industrial Millwright program at GBC. Next we have Jett Jacobs. Jett is a kind, charismatic, and outgoing young man. He enjoys playing sports and looks forward to returning to Round Mountain after finishing his welding certification at GBC.

Helping these graduates achieve this important step towards their future were was their Jobs for Nevada's Graduates instructor Kenndra Larsen. Kenndra and the J4NG program prepares teens for life after high school teaching skills and mentoring them through processes such as the MTC application. "I am so thrilled that we had four applicants this year for the MTC. It is rewarding to be a part of the journey with the kiddos. They were so nervous! They stepped out of their comfort zones a little bit to give it a shot and I am proud of each of them!" said Kenndra. RMHS Principal Sonja Miller has watched these four graduates grow and bloom for the last several years. "We are so proud of our four Knights who will go on to attend college with the help of the MTC Scholarship. Andy, Luis, Jett and Lila have shown grit and determination and we are excited to see what they will achieve with the trades they are learning," said Principal Miller.






