Renaissance Accelerated Reader

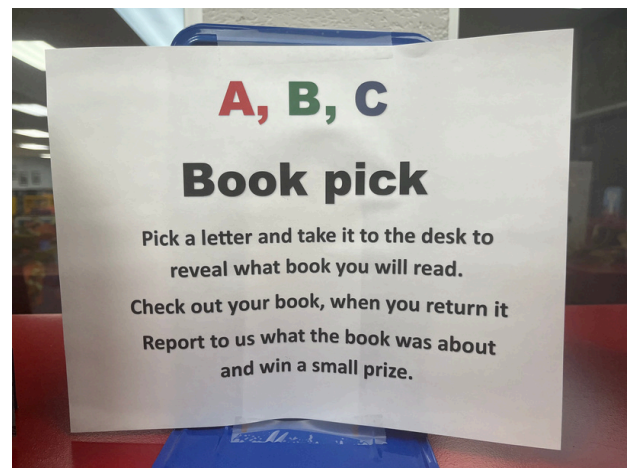
