

This remarkable library also houses a museum that was a dream of a local resident Walt Daniels. The museum has an amazing assortment of school material and local history exhibits. The Manhattan Library closes in the winter months due to high costs of heating the building, but we are open from the first Monday in April to the last Friday in October. 


