



## Blast from the Past: Nevada History




Thomas "Dry Wash" Wilson circa 1909

In 1907, Thomas "Dry Wash" Wilson struck gold in the mountains, marking the beginning of a legendary era in Round Mountain's history. Wilson's discovery led to the establishment of the Round Mountain Hydraulic Mining Company, which would go on to play a pivotal role in the region's mining industry.

But Wilson's impact didn't stop there. He revolutionized the mining process by inventing and successfully operating dry washing machines at the Round Mountain placers. This innovative technology allowed miners to extract gold from the dry soil, transforming the mining landscape forever.

Wilson's ingenuity and perseverance earned him fame and recognition, cementing his place in Round Mountain's rich history.






