

**A Little History of Round Mountain, Nevada**

Through the 20th century, Round Mountain saw booms, busts, and rebirths as mining technology advanced. When Kinross Gold began operating the modern open-pit mine, the town entered a new era, blending Nevada's frontier spirit with innovative mining. Today, Round Mountain remains a proud, hardworking community – a mix of miners, families, and adventurers surrounded by wide-open desert, mountain sunsets, and a rich history of perseverance. Whether you're passing through or calling it home, you're part of a story more than a century in the making.

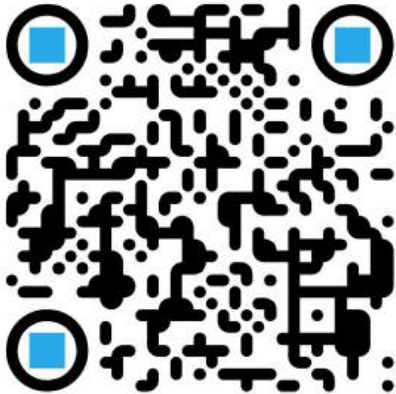
