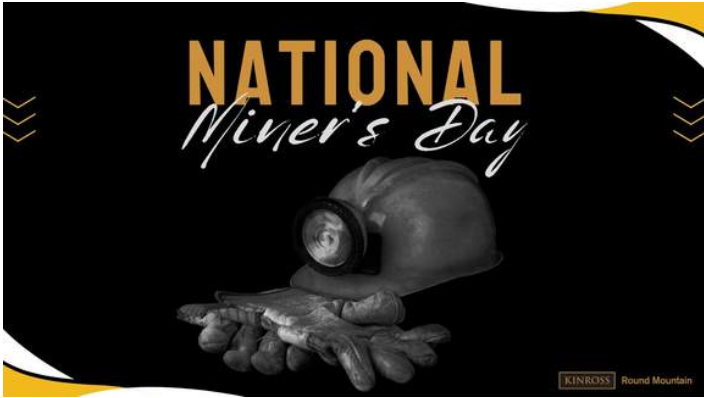

Accelerated Reader at the Round Mountain Public Library

Last school year, the Round Mountain Public Library hosted the Accelerated Reader Program. This program had been used by the school district in the past, and the library set up a dedicated area for testing. This program can be seen with color-coded spines on the books in the Children's area. This color coding lets students know what reading level the books are written in. Teachers or parents can request the librarians to assess what reading level a student is reading at by using the Accelerated Reading STAR test. Students can read books within their assessed reading level and test on books. The tests are designed to gauge the reading comprehension of the student. These tests are emailed to the teachers or homeschool parents. At the end of the school year, students can use their points earned to shop for prizes. Our local chapter of PTO paid for the prizes last year for our students. Our Accelerated Reader Program was funded by the Institute of Museum and Library Services. The grant funded the software subscription, reading tool kits for young readers, book bags, bookmarks, and the children's book collection for the last school year. This program has seen an increase in use and popularity. Our school has been a big supporter, and our homeschool families have continued to use this program. We would like to thank the members of our community who wrote letters to submit for the application of this grant, also we would like to thank our PTO for their support of this library program.

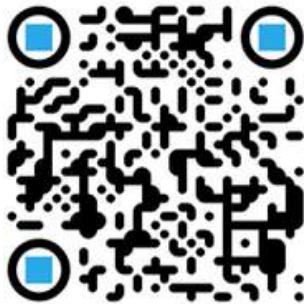
