Rather than playing to the tempo of their opponent, the Lady Knights enforced their own fast-paced, high-energy style, resulting in a commanding lead by halftime.

The second half continued in the same vein, with every player contributing to the win. Whether it was crucial steals, efficient passing, or hitting key shots in high-pressure moments, the team chemistry was on full display.

“These girls left it all out there on the court and proved why they deserved to be there as number one seed. Each of them worked hard all season and staying tight as a team is what brought them this trophy. I am so extremely proud of them!”

This victory solidifies the Lady Knights' spot in the upcoming state tournament, extending their undefeated streak and making them a formidable favorite for the NIAA State Championship. The win exemplifies a season defined by discipline, hard work, and, most importantly, a tight-knit group of girls playing for each other.

The Lady Knights will look to carry this momentum into the state playoffs, confident in their ability to play their game under pressure.

In the winter of 1952, the City of San Francisco streamliner, en route from San Francisco, became trapped in the deep snow of the Sierra Nevada about 20 miles west of Donner Pass after slamming into a massive snowslide.

For five days, 226 passengers and crew were entombed under nearly 17 feet of snow.

No electricity.

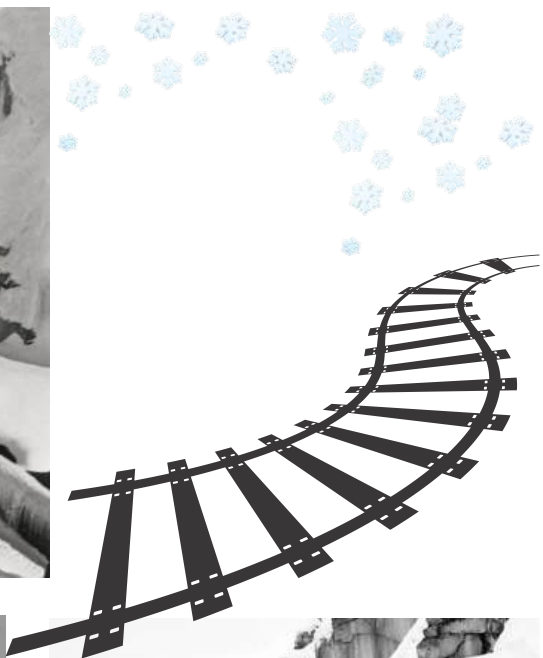
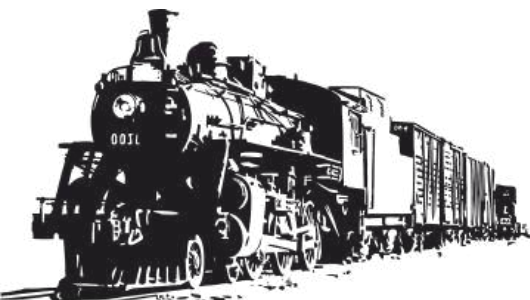
Frozen water.

From the Stacks : News from your Library



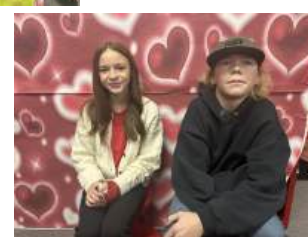
Valentine Party at the Round Mountain Public Library

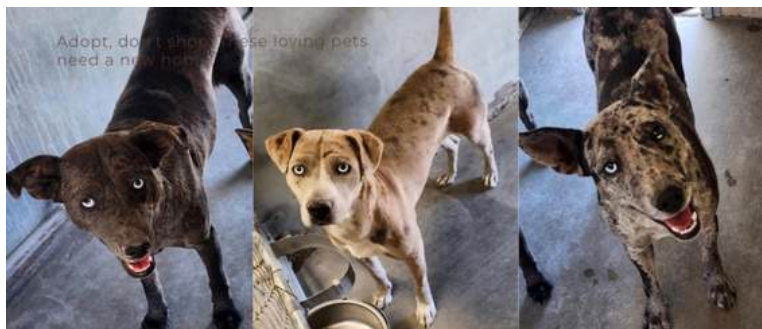

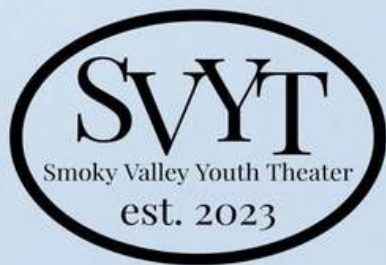

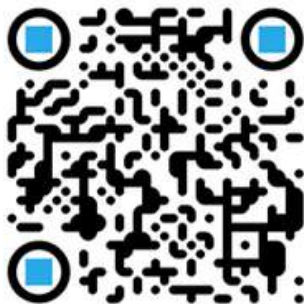
