Nevada Talking Book Services: Empowering Readers with Disabilities

Nevada Talking Book Services (NTBS) is a free library program that provides Braille and audio materials to Nevadans with visual or physical disabilities, enabling them to enjoy reading and learning without barriers. As part of the Library of Congress' National Library Service for the Blind and Print Disabled (NLS) network, NTBS offers a vast collection of fiction, nonfiction, and magazines in audio and Braille formats, catering to readers of all ages.

Eligibility and Services

To qualify, applicants must be Nevada residents with visual or physical disability, certified by a medical professional or authorized staff. Services include:

- ~**Audio and Braille Materials:** Borrowing and returning books, magazines, and music via postage-free mail
- ~**Digital Players:** Free digital players and refreshable Braille devices
- ~**Downloadable Content:** Access to Braille and Audio Reading Download (BARD) for digital books and magazines
- ~**Personalized Service:** Reader advisors help select books and provide recommendations

How to Apply

Interested individuals can apply online or by mail, with certification by a medical professional or authorized staff. Once approved, patrons receive their materials and player within weeks.

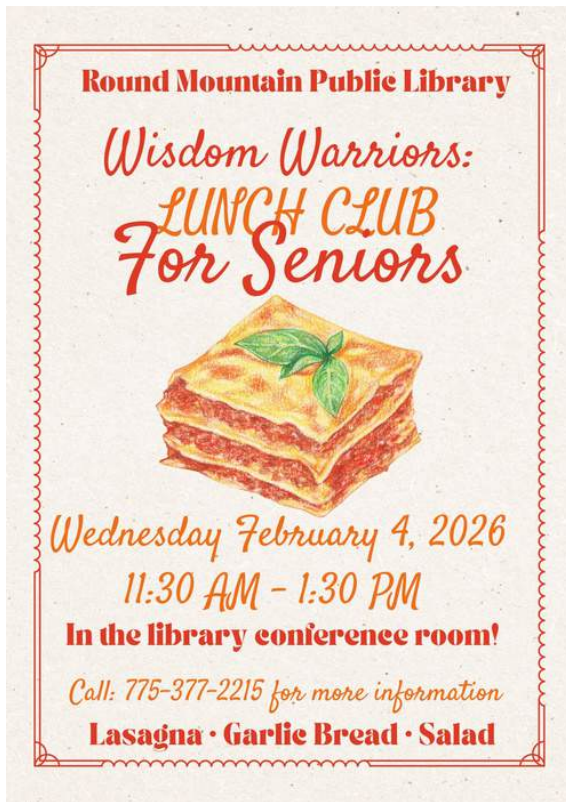
Impact and Reach

NTBS serves thousands of Nevadans, offering not just books, but independence empowerment, and connection. In 2020, over 149,000 titles circulated to eligible patrons.

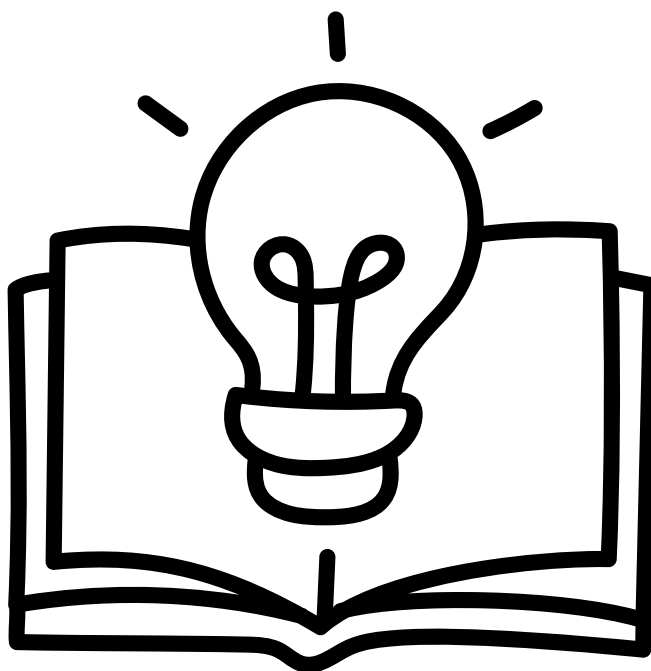

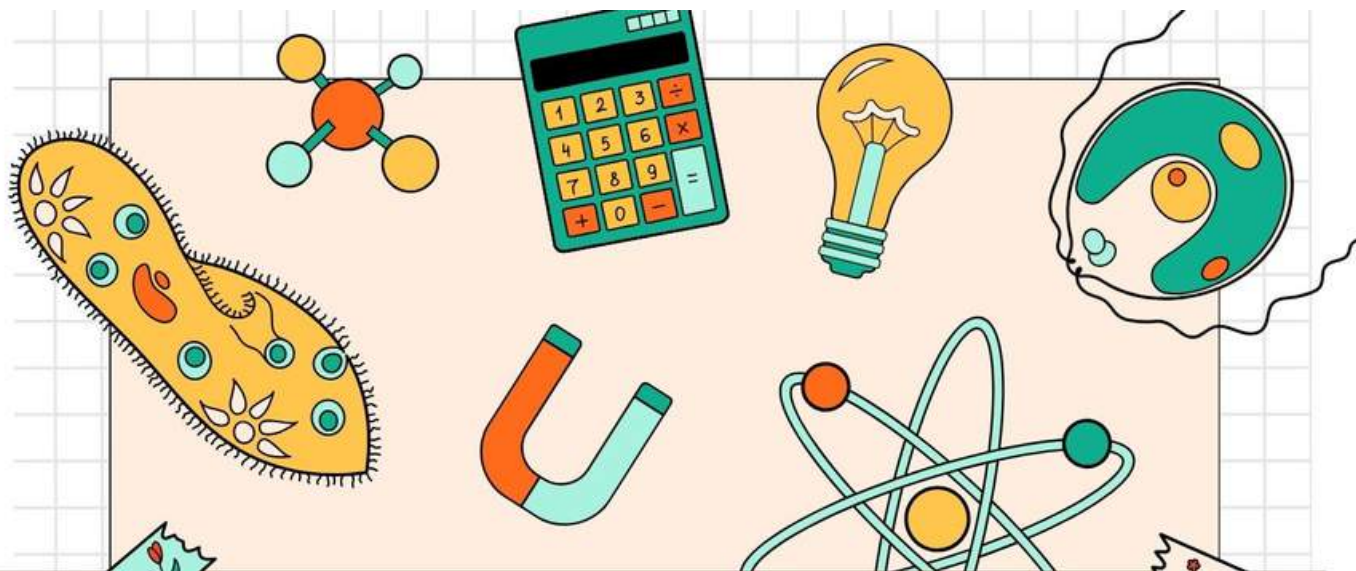
Blast From The Past: Goldfield Hotel

The Goldfield Hotel in Goldfield, Nevada, is a historic landmark that's been around since 1908. Built during the peak of Goldfield's gold rush, the hotel was a symbol of luxury and sophistication, earning accolades as the finest hotel between Chicago and San Francisco. Its construction cost around \$300,000, a hefty sum back then, and it boasted 154 rooms with telephones, electric lights, and steam heat.

The hotel's history is intertwined with George Wingfield, a mining magnate who played a significant role in Goldfield's development. It hosted notable guests, including President Theodore Roosevelt, and was a hub for social and economic elite. However, as the gold mines dried up, the hotel's fortunes declined, and it eventually closed in 1945.

Today, the Goldfield Hotel is listed on the National Register of Historic Places and is known for its haunted reputation, attracting paranormal enthusiasts and ghost hunters.



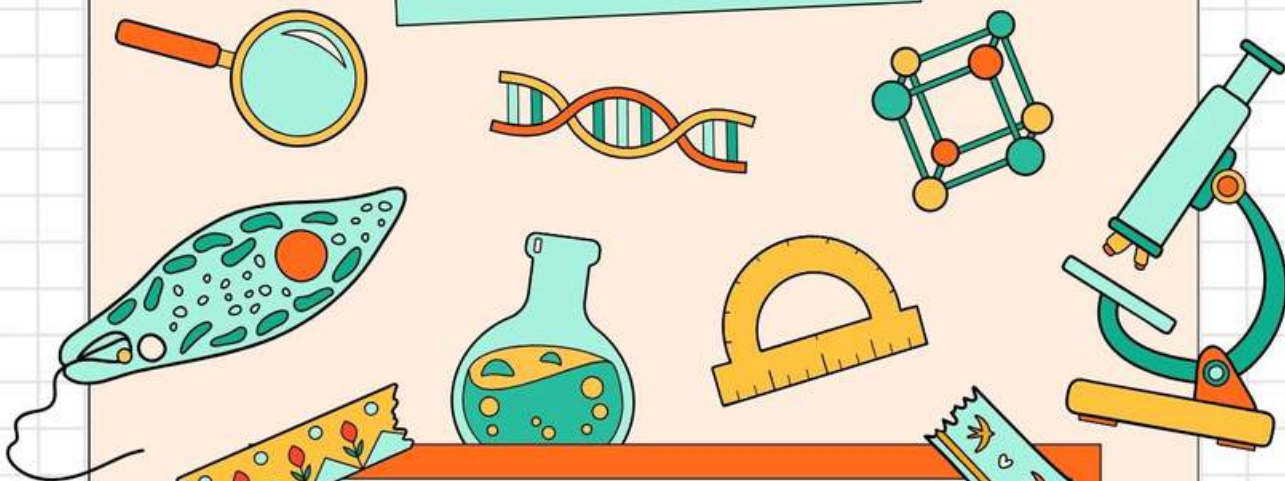

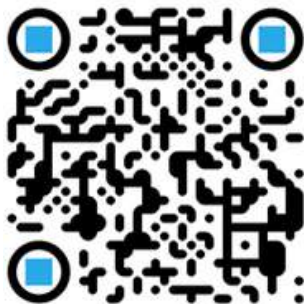
